ArtsConnect opened its doors with a renovated arts center in July of 2020. Who ever thought we would be opening under a pandemic! Although our opening was not as we had imagined, we quickly witnessed the impact the arts have on lives every day.

Comments such as, “This is my happy place” and “pottery is what I look forward to every week” are remarks we hear daily at the new arts center. One elementary student recently shared, “I see my friends online at school but I get to see my art teacher and make things here!” The joy the arts bring, especially in a socially distant world, *is our “why”*. We strive to bring you happiness, sense of accomplishment and even a stress relief to your day.

We are taking every precaution we can through the health advisory to make classes safe. But even with all measures in place, we have not reopened our daytime senior programming as it once was. We miss our seniors greatly and want them to know we think of them every day. We will continue to try Zoom programs and with the recent support of ArtsWave and the Federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (“CARES Act”), we have the technology to bring more programs online. We will communicate these new programming solutions through our e-news, social media, email and by phone when they are created.

We enter the New Year with anticipated recovery and we will continue our determined efforts to ensure safe and engaging activities. Please know that working to safely engage all community members, from child to senior, is a priority and renews the ArtsConnect goal to enrich lives through the healing power of the arts.

If you have not experienced an ArtsConnect program, I invite you to join us in creativity. You do not need to be a resident or member to participate, although a membership does give you the added value of discount rates on classes, events, summer camp and retail. Bring in your new year with renewed spirit and fill it with more activities that bring you and your family members joy and happiness.

Week 1: June 7 - 11 Puppets Galore!

Campers will learn how to build their own unique set of characters in various puppet forms. Marionettes, rod, and hand puppets will all be created using fabrics, 3D objects, and paper maché.

Week 2: June 14 - 18 Have Passport, will Travel

Campers will use their "passport" to enter Africa, China, Egypt, Australia and Ireland. Make an African drum, Chinese festival dragon, Egyptian clay sarcophagus, Australian animals, Aboriginal boomerang and Medieval 3-D Castles.

Week 3: June 21 - 25 Wonder Wheels

Each day of camp will be dedicated to a different kind of wheel. Projects consist of painting, weaving and metal tooling to design a game wheel, ferris wheel and a rubber band car.

Week 4: Jun 28 - Jul 2 Color Explosion!

Explore the properties of colored light and brilliant paints in a week filled with color, science and art! Campers will conduct colored light experiments, make prisms, lava lamps and kaleidoscopes. Experiment with paints and design oil pastel drawings.

Week 5: July 12 - 16 Night at the Museum

Camp comes to life with dinosaurs, woolly mammoths, cave men and Native American art. Projects will include clay dinosaurs, plaster fossils, cave art, gem and stone art, rain sticks and kachina dolls.

Week 6: July 19 - 23 Zoom In!

Enter the world of 3-dimensions. Learn about different artists and create 3-dimensional objects in optical illusion, clay sculpture, mobiles and bas reliefs.

Week 7: July 26 - 30 Fashion Fun!

We will create apparel and accessories based on a theme depicting a different region of the world. Campers will use sewing machines, hand sew, and create textile designs. At the end of the week, we will have a fashion show that will be live streamed so families can watch, even if they have to be at work.

Week 8: Aug 2 - 6 Invention Convention

Become inspired by some of the greatest inventors of all time, then create your own inventions. Campers will go through the invention process of planning and designing then making a model of their invention. They will work individually and collaboratively.

Week 9: Aug 9 - 13 Get Spacey

Campers will make art projects based on astronauts, planets, stars, rockets and aliens. Learn about famous astronauts and Alan Bean, astronaut and artist.

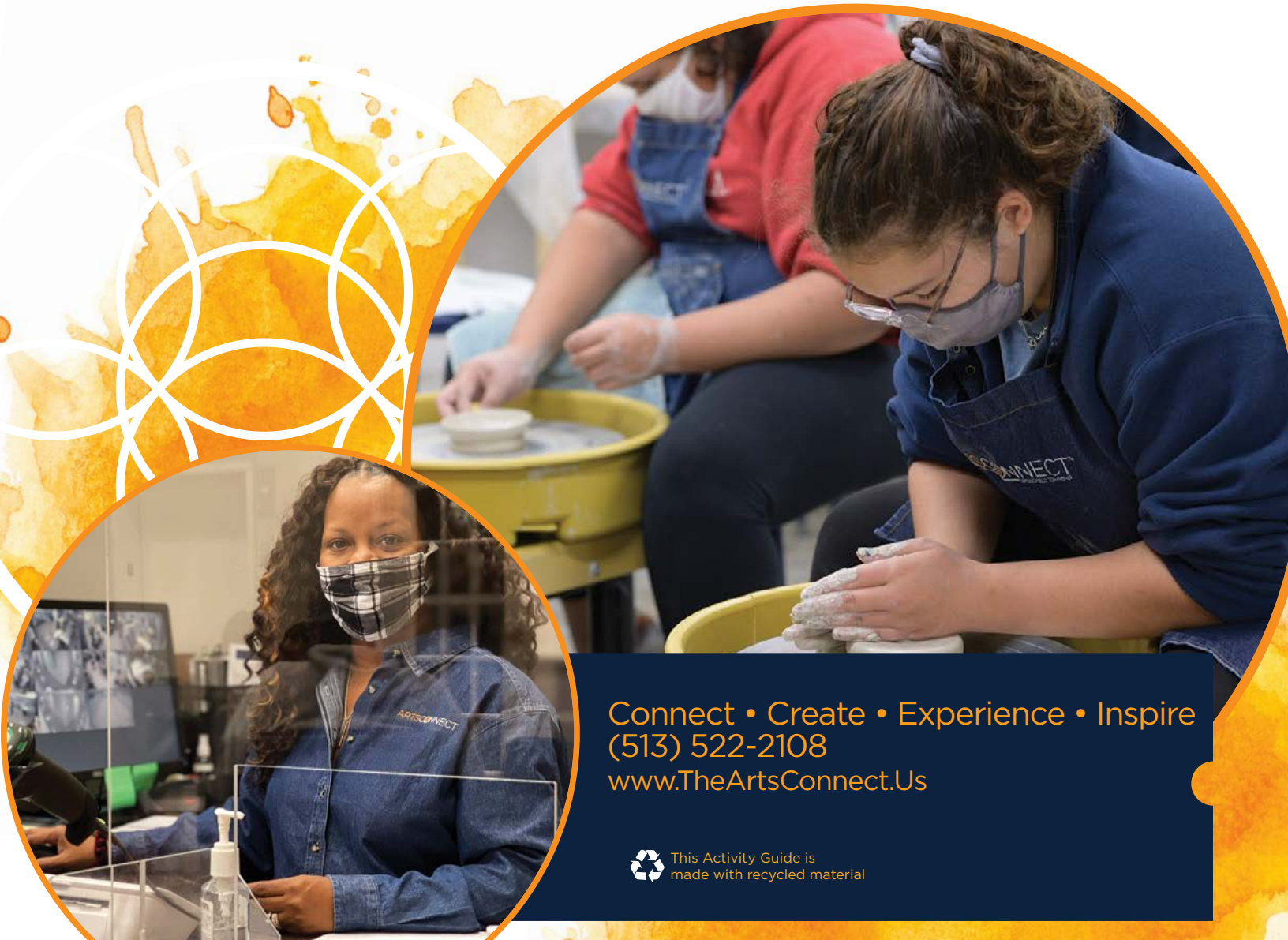
