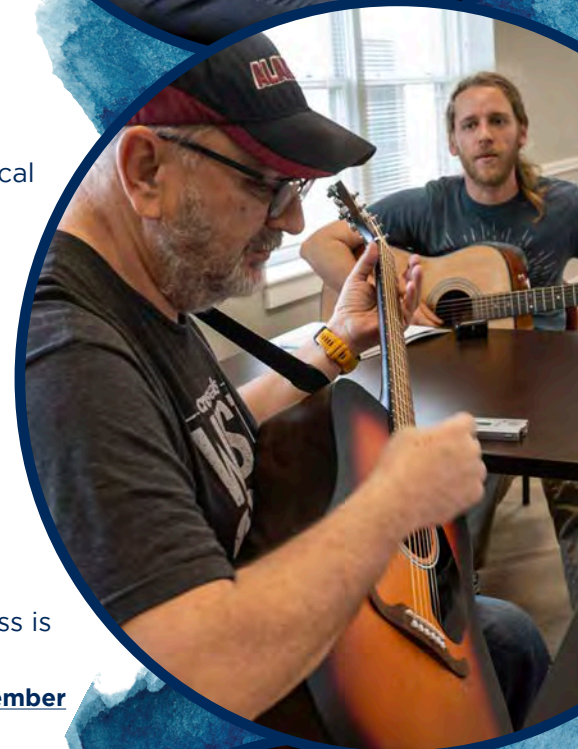
ALL SCHOOL KIDS THEATER: JUNGLE BOOK KIDS

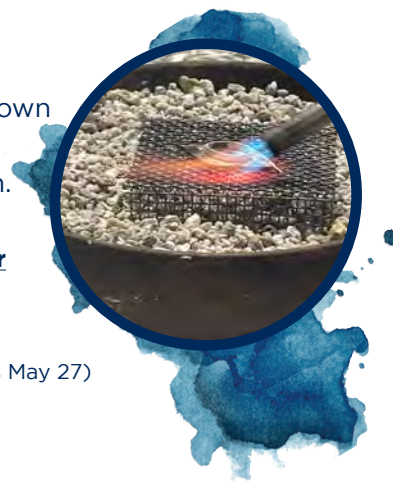
