STUDIO PASSES

ArtsConnect offers a fully equipped woodshop and a pottery studio with eight wheels. Studio passes provide access during regular Arts Center hours outside of classes. Open studio times are also available during certain days of the week in an art room for woodcarving, stained glass, and all-media art.

Size Limits:

All work should be between 3" and 11" in size. Any pieces outside these dimensions will not count towards classwork and will incur an additional fee, charged by weight for each firing.

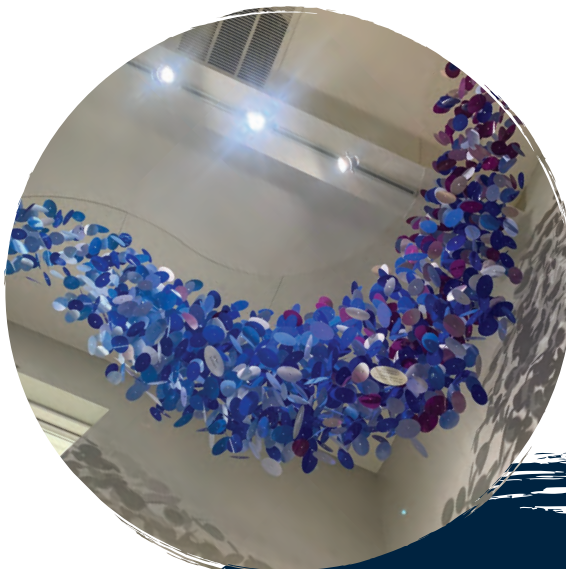
